

Safe Harbor School at Indian Oaks Academy Earns NCA Accreditation

Safe Harbor School at Indian Oaks Academy is newly-accredited by the Office of the North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement (NCA-CASI). NCA-CASI is part of a regional accrediting association that accredits more than 600 K-12 schools in Illinois.

Safe Harbor School was audited on November 11, 2010, and the NCA-CASI determined Safe Harbor meets or exceeds seven academic and program goals, compared to national standards. This accreditation is a huge benefit to our students: all Safe Harbor School credits will now fully transfer to another school, upon a client's discharge.
